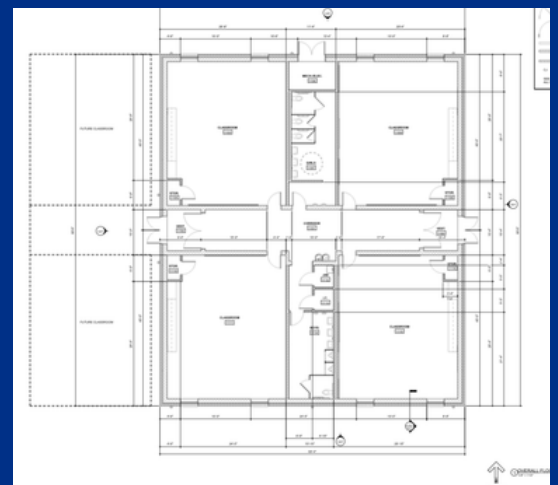
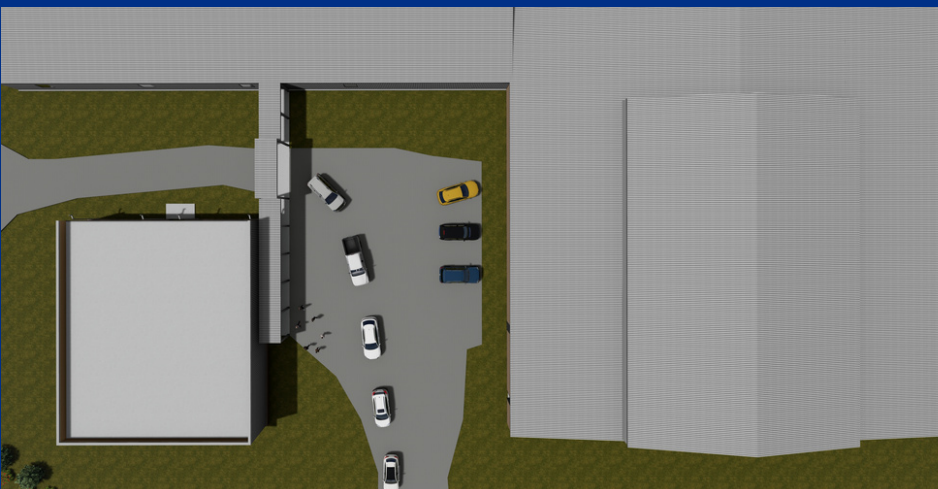
- Raise \$2 Million to Build a New 5,550 sq. ft. Structure Designed by Ward Scott Morris Architecture of Tuscaloosa

Why We're Building:

Southern Academy 1973

On May 27, 1973, fifteen minutes after the Class of 1973 had been dismissed from their Baccalaureate service, an F4 tornado producing winds of 210-261 mph completely destroyed our school and campus. While we currently need extra space for classrooms and weather forecasting technology has improved since then, we believe it is essential that we build a fortified structure to protect our students and staff in the event of another tornado that develops without enough notice to evacuate our campus. Current SA students, families and staff commuting from contingent counties and communities can be especially vulnerable in severe weather.
